



Restored Photos Returned As Digital Image Files

You may have your restored picture(s) returned in the form of a digital image file(s) on machine readable media which is analogous to getting traditional photographic negatives. You can make unlimited printed and electronic copies, display the pictures with a digital projector and on your TV screen, create e-mailable copies, embed pictures in electronic documents, and simplify commercial publication of genealogy documents with pictures.

All digital image files are created using Adobe® Photoshop®. The color space of master image and print image files is Adobe RGB(1998). Derived images for HDTV or digital projectors are converted to the sRGB color space for compatibility with consumer grade display devices.

Grand Images offers two general formats for the transmission of digital files.

Master Print Files

Master print image files only on an unlabeled CD/DVD, or user provided flash drive, or SD memory card. The master print files are LZW compressed TIFF files at 240 dpi, and sized to print at your largest specified size, (5x7, 8x10, 12x18", or whatever). TIFF is a popular image

transfer format and should be universally acceptable. A maximum quality JPEG version is also included to ensure readability.

This format is suitable for experienced users who have image processing software and can perform their own final image manipulations for intended use.

Archival Image Set

A comprehensive set of additional digital image files will be included for each master print image. This set would normally include a thumbnail, XGA digital projector, HDTV, an album sized, 4 x 6", and one other print size. Additional or other custom sized print files can be made per request, e.g. a version for your publisher, scrapbook, or web page. Be sure to specify if you have a need.

The derivative image files are JPEG formatted and some may be suitable for e-mailing. If the archival CD/DVD option is selected, optional printed disc and jewel case labels can be added, suitable for your pictorial archives. The digital label files are included so you can make duplicate labels.
